You will be provided with your own individual jigs or action models on which to practice procedures and solve problems for each exam task you choose to work on. Multiple instructors will be available to offer demonstrations, individual assistance, tips and feedback on your work, but you will spend as much time as you feel is needed to develop competence in your chosen task(s). You may spend the entire class working on the same repair or regulation task - or switch tasks in the middle, as many times as you wish. Prerequisite for Grand or Vertical Regulation: knowledge of basic regulation functions (or "steps") and familiarity with the tools needed. Prerequisite for repairs: familiarity with tools and materials. Class is open only to PTG Associate members. You must state your choice of tasks for this class (in order of preference) on the form below.
