# Hands-on Vertical Regulation Class

This class is open to anyone interested in learning how to regulate a vertical piano. The first 10 registrants will be able to work on three-note action models. So register right away! Additional class members will be able to observe and learn.

**Instructor: Richard West, RPT**

Richard is a PTG "Member of Note" award winner and has been around PTG longer than he'd care to admit. He has taught vertical and grand regulation several times. He actually wrote the book on grand regulation (*Grand Regulation Curriculum*) that is used in the Grand Regulation in 37 Steps class in the home office. He worked for over 30 years at the University of Nebraska and was a concert technician for several summers at the Aspen Music Festival.

**NOTE:** This class gives participants a head start on the PTG convention next summer. The Tucson Chapter is planning two other classes before the convention, a grand regulation class and a repair class, both of which are scheduled for spring of 2019.
